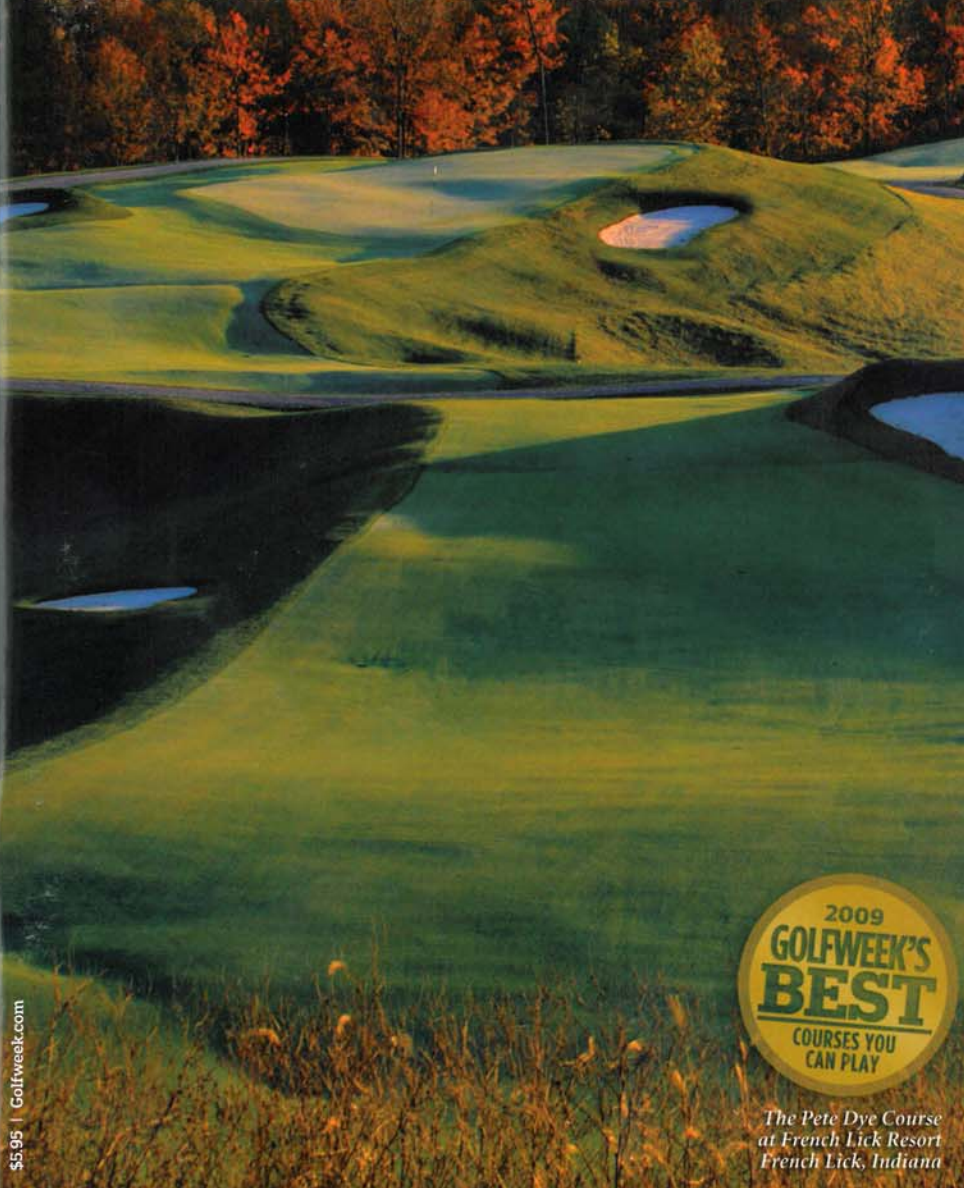

In 2004, Pine Needles famously underwent a substantial restoration at the hand of master architect John Fought, resulting in a modernized course that still remains true to the spirit of Ross' early creation.
